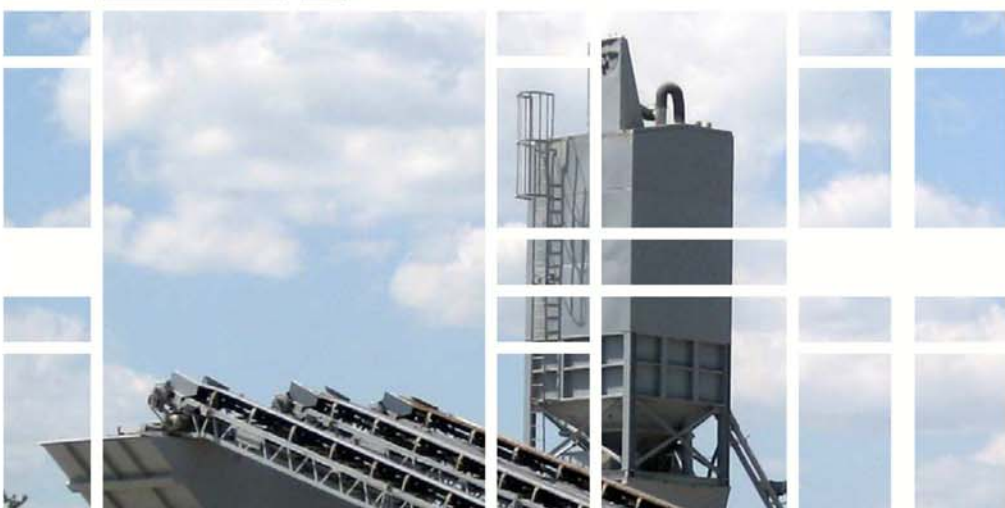

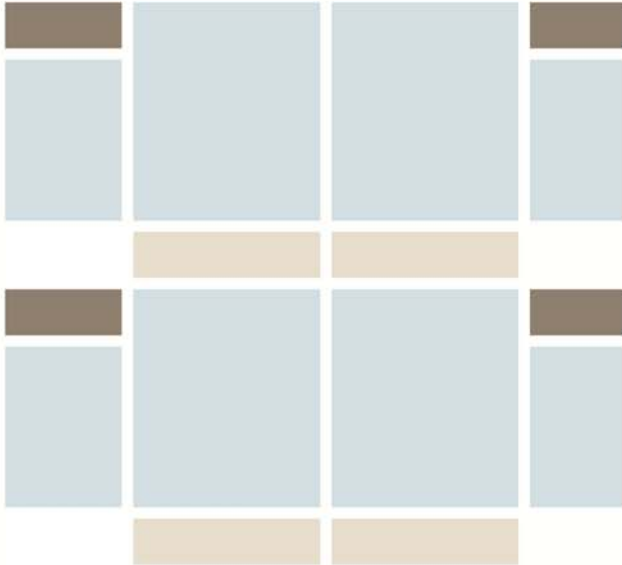

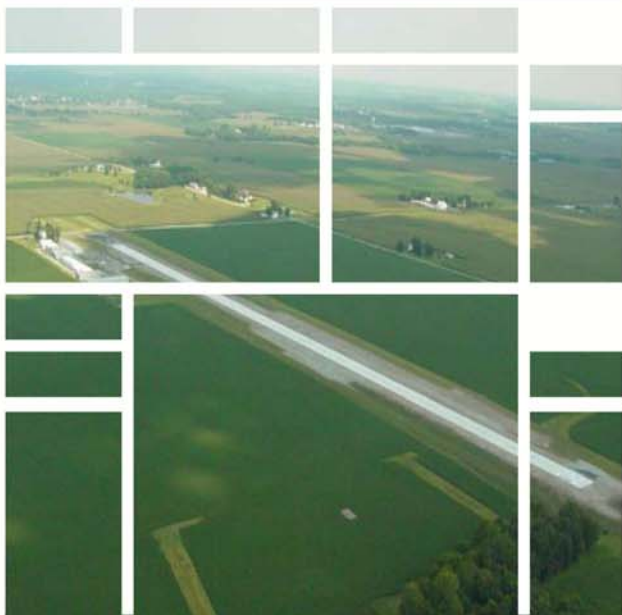

CORE NATIONAL FUNCTIONS...

LIASON WITH GOVERNMENT

ACPA is called upon for advice in pavement matters by the Federal Highway Administration, the Federal Aviation Administration, and the military Tri-Services. ACPA recommendations on design, specification and construction procedures are highly regarded by these agencies, as well as state, and local agencies that are served by our Chapter/State network. ACPA also works closely with other national organizations on matters affecting the concrete pavement industry, including the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials, the American Concrete Institute, the National Association of County Engineers, the American Public Works Association and the Transportation Research Board. ACPA members are represented in dealing with these organizations as they could not be individually.

ADVOCACY

ACPA brings the full constituency of the concrete pavement industry to legislators in Washington DC, working closely with partners in the Transportation Construction Coalition and other allied advocacy groups. ACPA's PAC helps us support legislators who support transportation funding and concrete pavement research legislation.

INFORMATION CENTRAL

ACPA is the clearinghouse of the industry, gathering and disseminating (via web sites, magazine, tech sheets and presentations) the latest developments in equipment, materials, construction methods, roadway and airport design, specifications, and research. This ensures the highest quality in workmanship and the most efficient use of equipment, materials, and new technology in the construction of concrete pavements. It also ensures that specifying agencies have up-to-the-minute information available when preparing pavement design and specifications.

PUBLICATIONS & SOFTWARE

ACPA publishes documents and software to promote best practices and provide a consensus industry view on concrete pavements. ACPA documents represent contractor's experiences and use member task forces to develop the content.

Our expert staff and the breadth of our services are recognized throughout the world. These resources give our industry a seat at the table in Washington D.C. and valuable national perspectives for Chapter/State affiliates and state/local agencies.

COOPERATIVE RESEARCH

ACPA supports the CP Tech Center and research technology development projects on high-priority issues. Industry support of concrete pavement research is vital to the continual improvement needed to meet our customer's needs.

PERSONAL COUNSELING

Chapter/State affiliates, members and customers are provided with the support of national experts to help resolve challenges and build better roads and airport facilities at less cost. Such assistance is readily available through the Association and our CP Tech Center partners. Our experts can address issues like new technology implementation, quality control problems, interpretation of specifications, value engineering proposals, concrete mixture evaluation, jointing, and many other issues encountered in the field and through working with specifying agencies.

TRAINING

ACPA and our CP Tech Center partner conduct special training opportunities for both member and specifying agency personnel. The training is provided through a variety of means, including face-to-face courses, web-based seminars and training on demand. Training of agency personnel is the primary focus of affiliated ACPA Chapter/State Associations with the CP Tech Center, while training member companies is ACPA's primary national training focus availing the expertise of the Association's allied members.

PROMOTION

ACPA supports Chapter/State affiliates on their local promotion activities and initiatives, bringing the national perspective to support local messaging.



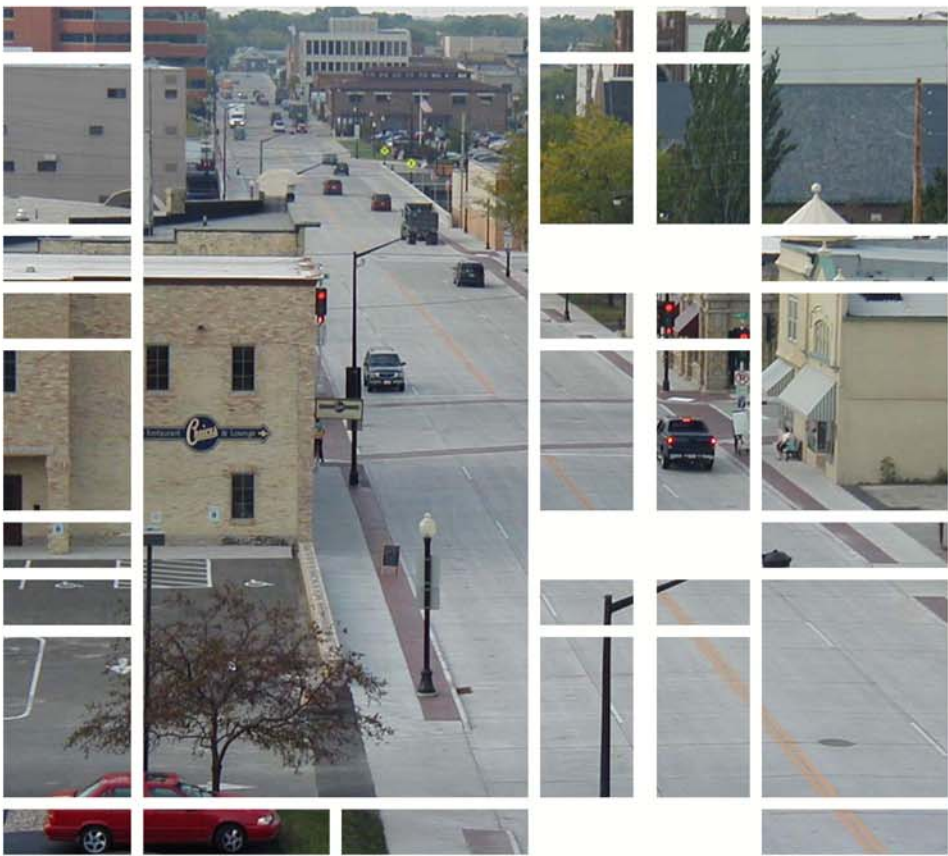
ANNUAL MEETING
